





What Does the Body Have to Do With Faith Formation?

The **theology of the body** has become a fairly popular topic over the years, but the degree of exposure for students and teachers alike is quite varied. Whether it's seen as a chastity or sexuality program, just a term we've heard in passing, or understood to be a baseline for knowing who we are as persons, we can all go a little deeper. Just like math or science, it needs to be revisited over and over to really draw upon its benefits in everyday life.
